The 24-hour Caregiver Core Training is made up of eight sessions with a break for field experience at the mid-point. The sessions are designed to help you understand how the system works and what your role is as a member of the team. Topics that will be covered will include how caregiving may impact your own family, how to effectively work with birth families in order to best support the child, child development and the impact of trauma, attachment issues, how to incorporate and honor a child's culture into your own family, and more. The sessions include the voices of former foster youth, current caregivers and birth parents who have been involved with the system.
