

## **Caregiver Core Training-Olympia**

Caregiver Core Training is mandatory for caregivers to become licensed. The 24-hour training is made up of eight sessions, each three consecutive hours, and a break for Field Experience at mid-point.

Session 1: Introduction to the Child Welfare System

Session 2: Working as a Member of the Team

Session 3: Working with Birth Families

Session 4: Cultural Connections and Advocacy

Session 5: Growing Up with Trauma, Grief and Loss

Session 6: Understanding and Managing Behavior

Session7: Communication and Crisis Management

Session 8: Getting Ready and the Effects on the Caregiving Family

**Field Experience:** Participants have the opportunity to learn outside the classroom by choosing an activity that will give them more awareness of the experience of children within the system or of the role of a caregiver.
